After a delicious local dinner on board the ferry, you can linger in the various shops or enjoy the wide range of entertainment available for all ages.

Overnight on board the ferry.

Day 3

Amsterdam – a city full of surprises. Explore Amsterdam on an exciting canal cruise. Visit Keukenhof till 20th May. 21st May onwards, visit Madurodam - Holland in miniature. Then proceed to Cologne. Visit the biggest Gothic Cathedral in Europe – the Cologne Cathedral..

After a continental breakfast on board, disembark the ferry. Then sit back and relax in your coach as we proceed to Amsterdam. On arrival, board your glass-topped boat as we sail through the canals for an exciting canal cruise. The city's colorful past comes alive with its 1,000 bridges and fine old houses on your tour of Amsterdam. Next, proceed to Lisse village to visit Keukenhof – the largest spring garden in the world. Bulbs of colorful tulips bloom only till May 20th. Be enchanted by the indoor floral displays and colourful flower beds amongs tancient trees. 21st May onwards, we take you to visit Madurodam, where you can see most of Holland in miniature, replicated in minute detail on a 1:25 scale. Visit a cheese farm and a wooden shoe factory. See a demonstration of how cheese is made and wooden shoes are carved out of wooden blocks. You also have a chance to savour some cheese. Enroute, stop at a windmill – the most common sight in Holland for a photograph. Next, proceed to Cologne. Visit the impressive Cologne Cathedral, a fine example of amazing Gothic architecture. This evening, after a delicious local dinner, drive to your hotel and check in.

Overnight at Park Inn / NH or similar in Cologne.

Day 4

A romantic cruise on the River Rhine. Next, visit Hofgut Sternen – heart of the Black Forest.

After a Continental breakfast, check out and proceed to board your scenic cruise on the River Rhine. Cruising down the Rhine, you will pass steep slopes covered with vineyards. After enjoying the scenic river Rhine cruise we drive into Hofgut Sternen. This is the heart of the Black Forest, surrounded by dark fir forests, fairy tale woods and flowering meadows. Get invited for a free demonstration of cuckoo clock and buy one for your home – a prized possession. This evening, after a delicious local dinner, drive to your hotel and check in.

Overnight at the Best Western or similar in Hofgut Sternen.

Day 5

View the spectacular Rhine Falls in Schaffhausen. Today get set for a day full of fun and excitement as we take you to visit Mt. Titlis with its beautiful scenery and an adventurous ride up the snow-clad Swiss Alps in Rotair – the world's first revolving cable-car.

After a continental breakfast at the hotel, check out, sit back and relax in your coach as we drive into Schaffhausen to view the magnificent Rhine Falls. Later we take you on one of the most memorable experiences of your Europe tour visiting Mt. Titlis. Marvel at the world's first revolving cable-car ride, a truly once-in-a lifetime experience. Remain spellbound as you ascend the snow-clad mountains. Experience the snow and ice on top of Mt. Titlis. At 3,020 metres a breathtaking panorama unfolds. Next, we proceed to scenic Lucerne, where you will visit the Lion Monument and the Kapell Brucke wooden bridge. Later, you have some free time to shop for famous Swiss watches knives and chocolates. This evening, after a delicious local dinner, drive to your hotel and check in.

Overnight at Hotel Park Inn/ Ramada or similar in Zurich or Hotel Central / Angels Lodge or similar in Central Switzerland.

Day 6

Day at leisure OR you have a chance to join us on an all inclusive Alpine excursion tour to the wonderful world of Jungfrauoch – the top of Europe – at 3,454 metres. Get set for a memorable experience.

This morning, after a continental breakfast, the day is at leisure OR you can opt to visit the top of Europe Jungfrauoch. Get ready for an adventurous ride to visit Jungfrauoch – The Top of Europe, for a memorable encounter with snow and ice – a genuine 'high-point' of your tour! Sit back in your coach as we proceed to the beautiful town of 'Lauterbrunnen', where the excitement continues. This is a trip to another world – a wonderful world of eternal ice and snow. Experience the magic of the mountains and visit the Ice Palace and many new attractions all included on top of the longest glacier in the Alps. Later, we visit Interlaken, a

charming city nestled between two lakes and surrounded by the splendid Bernese Oberland Mountains. Today after a delicious local meal for dinner we drive back to your hotel.

Overnight at Hotel Park Inn/ Ramada or similar in Zurich or Hotel Central / Angels Lodge or similar in Central Switzerland.

Day 7

Romantic Venice – crossed by canals, beautiful monuments, the city that inspires poetry and passion.

After a continental breakfast at the hotel, check out and drive to Venice. On arrival at the pier, board a private boat which will take you to the heart of the traditional city of Venice – The St. Mark's Square. This astonishingly wonderful lagoon city is a special delight to visitors. Sail over the Guidecca Canal, as you catch a glimpse of the serene waters of the Adriatic Sea. On arrival, admire The St. Mark's square with the Basilica, Doge's Palace, Campanile and Bridge of Sighs. Also visit the Murano Glass showroom. This evening, after a delicious local dinner check into your hotel.

Overnight at Europa or similar in Rovigo.

Day 8

Re-live the history of Rome in this ancient city's great landmarks. Marvel at the Colosseum. Visit the world's smallest country – the Vatican City which includes the Vatican Museum, the Sistine Chapel and the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica on the guided tour of Rome and Vatican City.

After a continental breakfast at your hotel, check out and relax in your coach as we drive to Rome. On arrival meet your English - speaking guide who will take you to the Vatican City– the smallest country in the world. (Shorts or sleeveless vests not allowed.) First stop at the Vatican Museum, with a visit to the world-famous Sistine Chapel – a pure source of inspiration for tourists , specially included on your tour. This will be followed by a visit to the holy Basilica of St. Peter's – the incomparable home of architectural and artistic masterpieces by Michelangelo and Bernini, which will leave you awestruck.. Next, see the Colosseum known for its gladiator fights. Later, discover many of the renowned attractions of Rome – Trevi Fountain, Victor Emmanuel monument on Piazza Venezia under which lies the Tomb of the unknown soldier, Circus Maximus which is known for its chariot races, the ancient ruins of Roman Forum and many more. Tonight, enjoy a delicious local dinner. After a memorable day we drive to your hotel and check in.

Overnight at Hotel Palace / President or similar in Rome.

Day 9

Visit Florence – the cradle of the Renaissance, former home of the Medicis. Next, visit Pisa and see the Leaning Tower of Pisa.

After a continental breakfast at the hotel, check-out and board the coach as we drive you to Florence – the capital of Tuscany. On arrival, meet your english speaking local guide who will show you the Duomo, Campanile, the Baptistry with its Gates to Paradise, Piazza Della Signoria – an open-air museum of sculptures, Ponte Vecchio Bridge which is across the river Arno and the Piazzale Michelangelo with the impressive statue of David. Later we drive to Pisa to visit the Square of Miracles. Remain spellbound as you approach this precariously leaning tower. Tonight, enjoy a delicious local dinner. Later drive to your hotel and check in.

Overnight at My One / Datini or similar in Pisa / Prato / Florence or similar..

Day 10

Onto Geneva. Orientation tour of Geneva.

This morning, after a continental breakfast, check out and sit back in your coach as we drive to Geneva. Geneva has the best of both worlds and could well be called the 'Garden city' situated on the shores of Lac Lemman. On the orientation tour of Geneva where you will see the Jet d' Eau – the tallest fountain in Europe (weather permitting), rising to a height of 400 – 500 ft, the United Nations building, the floral clock, the English gardens and the International Red Cross building. We then take you for a delicious local dinner at a restaurant. Later drive to your hotel and check in.

Overnight at Hotel Ferney Voltaire / Park Inn or similar in Geneva.

Day 11

Overnight at Hotel Novotel / Mercure or similar in Paris.

Day 12

Today, enjoy the sights of Paris on a guided city tour. You also have a chance to visit the world renowned Louvre Museum and the brilliant Versailles Palace. Enjoy a breathtaking view of Paris from the Eiffel Tower (2nd Level).

After a continental breakfast at your hotel, we take you on a city tour of Paris with an English speaking local guide, who will show you many of the best-loved Parisian sights – Alexander Bridge, Arc de Triomphe, Concorde Square, Opera House, Invalides, Champs Elysees and many more. Later, the day is at leisure or you have a chance to visit the world renowned Louvre Museum to see the incomparable and the most prestigious painting of 'Mona Lisa' – Leonardo da Vinci's masterpiece and many more. You also have a chance to visit Versailles Palace – set on impressive grounds and steeped in memories of major historic events. Visit the Chateau and the Gardens of Versailles, some of the most prestigious monuments of the world's artistic heritage. Vast chambers and private apartments of unimaginable luxury include an opera hall, a chapel, and the famous Hall of Mirrors. You can stroll along the gardens, which form an extension of the architectural construction. The vast proportions, the novelty, the variety of effects and views makes this garden one-of-a kind in the world. We shall then proceed to visit the Eiffel Tower (2nd level), from where you will have a splendid view of this beautiful city. Later in the evening enjoy a delicious local dinner.
